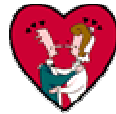

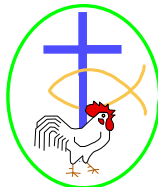

You took the fall, and thought of me, above all.

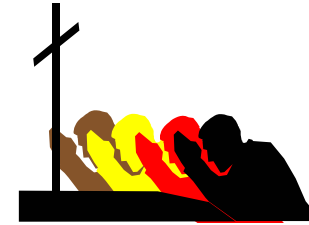
