IMB missionaries **BUCK and LESLIE BURCH**, who formerly lived in Bryansk, were there the day five young people were baptized in the freezing waters of the Desna River — the same river where ice fishermen were trying their luck that day. You were part of this celebration, thanks to your faithful support through the Cooperative Program (CP). The water was cold, but the hearts of the Arnolds were warmed to see, after years of prayer, young people commit their lives to become fishers of men. 


