Tomorrow, Mon., Jan. 25th at 5:00 p.m.. **Anyone can come!** If you would like to help plan church events and activities, please come.

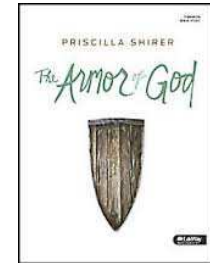
Starting Tomorrow, Monday, On January 25th:

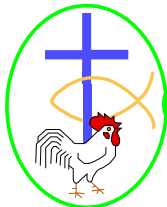
