THOMAS THOMPSON is thankful for Southern Baptist supporters who gave his family their "dream job." The Thompsons serve in Estonia. Its people tend to be extremely private, which hinders sharing the gospel with them. Even so, Thomas has enjoyed some successes. He and his family helped start an international church in Tallinn, Estonia's capital city. While he is busily translating the Gospels into Southern Estonian, Thomas also teaches at a local school where he is permitted to share his faith. Those successes, perhaps, pale in comparison to his sharing the gospel with "K," a woman serving an 18-month prison sentence. Although K had rejected a chaplain's attempts to reach out to her, she saw something different in Thomas while he taught English to her fellow inmates. No longer behind prison walls, K is learning the basics of the Christian faith. Pray for K to accept Christ.

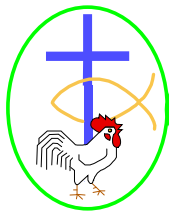
