# Missionary Moment Clean Spring Water

(Central Asia) A Southern Baptist family living in Central Asia works to improve people's physical lives by piping clean spring water into communities and teaching about better health practices. But opportunities to share their faith are few and far between. In their small town, all the local people are Muslim, and everyone knows each other's business. Despite the difficulty, the family works to build close relationships with their national partners and shows Christ's love through their life and ministry. Cooperative Program gifts make it possible not only to provide clean water to the people of Central Asia, but also to offer them the eternal Living Water found in Christ.
