

DANIEL BYRD, previously a vice president for Nike, now has no Internet access or air conditioning. But he does have chickens and pigs just outside his window. Daniel has a heart for the Roma gypsies living in the mountains of Romania. Viewed as outcasts, Roma gypsies were not always allowed to attend services at the Romanian church in the village, but God has changed people's hearts. Romanian believers and Roma gypsies now worship together, and Daniel calls the more than 80 Roma youth who come to his monthly Bible study his "children." Daniel gladly takes villagers to the market—his is the only car in the village—and joins in the celebration at each seasonal feast. Praise God for moving among the Roma gypsies. 
