

Mondays at 6:30 p.m.



New Bible Study Starts Next Sunday Night - “Daniel”



The Book of Daniel provides an historical account of how the Lord protected and provided for His faithful followers while in captivity; it also includes a vision of future redemption and hope. Missionary Moment

EARL and ROBIN PINKSTON feel privileged to work in Malta, the site of Paul's shipwreck on his way to Rome. It's a tiny island country, but the Pinkstons have plenty of company. About 440,000 people make their home on two islands totaling just 22 miles in length. Most of the Maltese are nominal Catholics, but many of them still need to hear God's plan of salvation. To help multiply their witness, the Pinkstons depend on Southern Baptists in the U.S. and other church members overseas to "adopt" Maltese villages for prayer. All 68 Maltese villages on the two islands have been adopted, and the Pinkstons hope volunteer teams will join in the work. Pray for volunteer teams to come share their faith with the Maltese people. 
