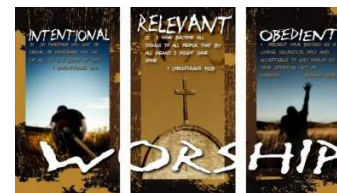


**Next Sunday Morning

## International Missionaries – Prayer Requests

Missionary Lynne Holder writes: “I feel like I’m in a different world as I sit in my air-conditioned kitchen, listen to the hum of the dryer, and work on my computer. Outside, riding lawn mowers traverse the neighbors’ yards, people rush to do errands in their cars, and life passes by at a quickening pace. This is the United States, and I’m on stateside assignment, a period of time when we return to the U.S. to share with churches what the Lord is doing in our part of the world--South Africa. It’s so easy to get caught up in the dazzle of everything. But then I see a young Asian man buying bananas at Wal-Mart, a Middle Eastern family looking for summer clothes, a Native American driving quickly through the parking lot--and I remember. No matter where I go, there are people who need to hear the Good News of Jesus. Not only do they need to hear, but they need to see it. What difference does the Good News make in my life? Can others see Jesus in me? New believers are being baptized and then disciple by members of the Kobe/Hyogo Team in Japan. The fear of man is a huge barrier to the spread of the Gospel in Japan, so it is vital to cover these young believers in prayer. The team asks that barriers of fear and tradition be broken so that they will share faithfully.

\* Also pray with Lynne for the people of the Coloured community of South Africa where she serves that they will seek everlasting life.

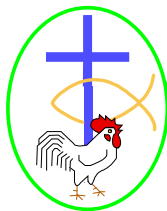
