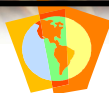

There are 18 Chinese students at West Hills College that want to learn American Culture and they could use meals this summer due to budgeting problems. Please contact Pastor for details.

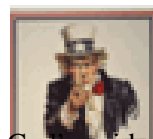


Love Offering for Manuel

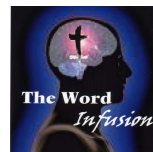
Budget Committee Meeting

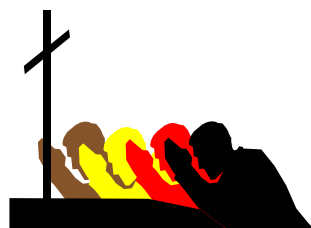
