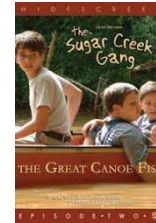
Next Time You Are At The Grocery Store...

Missionary Moment: Intentionally Sharing the Gospel

(Minnesota) FUE CHEE HER, a second-generation Hmong, is a church planter in metro Minneapolis/St. Paul. The Hmong people are an Asian ethnic group from the mountainous regions of China and Southeast Asia. Recognizing that the spiritual needs of second-generation Hmong are different from first generation, he planted Gospel Hmong Baptist Church. This church is a contemporary church that worships, teaches and preaches in English because some young families have a difficult time understanding and speaking the Hmong language. As you support the Cooperative Program, pray that the second-generation Hmong will open their hearts and be receptive to the Gospel of Jesus Christ and that the church will be intentional in sharing the Gospel.
