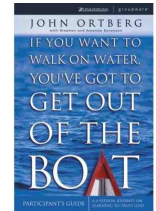

California Missions Moment

"Church gets bold and goes beyond its walls"

Beyond the Walls Community Church in Temecula is not trying to compete with other churches; it wants to complete other churches. Its mission is to reach people who aren't being reached by other churches. And there are plenty of unreached people to go around! Church planter Demetric Felton is the bivocational pastor of the congregation. He is also an officer and chaplain in the U.S. Navy, stationed at nearby Camp Pendleton. He and his wife, Lennette, a homemaker, began the church in their home in July 2012. While still meeting there, he baptized more than 20 people in their backyard. Within four months, the church plant grew from four couples to more than 40 regular attenders. "We had to find another place to meet," Demetric said with a laugh, "because we couldn't fit any more people in our living room!" The church moved into rented space at a local elementary school in November 2012 and is still meeting there. For a long time, a typical Sunday morning for Emir and Nikia Leslie did not include church. "We'd get up and say to each other, 'We need to be in church,'" said Nikia. "I'd pick up my Bible, but it was like trying to read French. I just didn't get anything out of it." After getting acquainted with Lennette, the Leslies, though skeptical, decided to give Beyond the Walls a try. "It all starts with a conversation," Lennette said, adding that talking about what the church is and what it offers, then inviting someone to come is the first step. 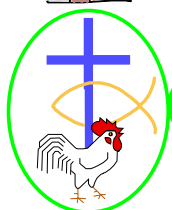
