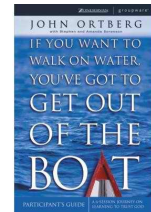

California Missions Moment

"Disaster relief teams offer hope, not just help"

FRESNO -- When Typhoon Haiyan devastated the Philippines in November 2013, more than 6,000 people lost their lives. In parts of the islands, near total destruction was left behind. California Southern Baptists didn't just sit watching the horrific scenes on television. They went to help rebuild churches, houses and schools. They helped survivors clean up what was left. But most of all, they carried life-giving, life-saving hope. "Anyone can give help in a disaster; but only Christians can bring true, living hope," said Don Hargis, California Southern Baptist Convention Disaster Relief coordinator. The Convention sent 11 teams to the Philippines in the past year. Hargis and others went ahead of the teams to do logistics and survey what would be needed. ... He said that thanks to the California Mission Offering, his group has the funds to keep more than 50 pieces of equipment up and running and ready to go on short notice anywhere they are needed. "The money that comes from our churches through CMO goes to pay our expenses, repair our equipment and buy new when that becomes necessary," he explained. More than 4,000 Californians have been trained in the five C's of disaster relief work: cooking, chainsaws, cleanup, communication and chaplaincy. ... 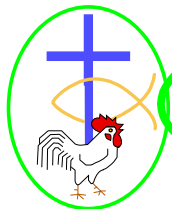
