California Missions Moment

REACHING
THE WORLD
IN CALIFORNIA

Church starting is a primary strategy for California Southern Baptists to reach the Golden State for Christ. In October 2010, God blessed California Southern Baptists' 10-10-10 initiative, as more than 40 church plants sponsored significant events during the Oct. 8-10 weekend.

From the northern part of the Golden State to the Mexico border, new groups sponsored outreach events, held preview services or launched new congregations.

Ross Shepherd, California Southern Baptist Convention new church starting specialist, said 10-10-10 began as an initiative to start 10 churches in the Bay Area on Oct. 10. "It has grown from an initiative to a movement - a movement of God - that we believe has value, visibility and viability."

Some 30 Anglo/multi-culture, a dozen ethnic and two African-American congregations were involved in 10-10-10, Shepherd said. Reports indicate the combined church planting efforts will have involved more than 4,000 persons.

Several preview and launch services had as many as 200 attending, including Epic Church in San Francisco and Rock Bible Church in Pleasanton.
