

California Missions Moment

Block Party Trailers

As a means of reaching out to a hard-to-reach community, Wonder Valley Community Church threw a block party at the community park. Inland Empire Baptist Association offered the use of a Block Party Trailer, courtesy in part of funds from the California Mission Offering, which has provided 13 such trailers for 14 California Southern Baptist associations. The Wonder Valley block party consisted of the usual block party assortment of bouncy house, snow cones, popcorn and carnival fare, plus face-painting, pony rides, booths of local artisans and craftspeople, and a band on a stage provided by the Marine base. About 100 people attended –three times the average Sunday attendance at Wonder Valley Church, which is the oldest established church in the area, and “the only one that still has a steeple and a bell-tower that works,” says Brooks. “One of the best things about the block party was just the fact of the church experiencing cooperation with each other, working together to make something happen,” Brooks says. Block party trailers, which last about seven years, are employed 35-50 times per year, and on average, seven people accept Christ at Evangelistic Block Parties. Six people can set up a block party trailer in 20 minutes. The trailers thus have much potential as tools for evangelism. **More of this article at www.calmissions.com**


