A chicken-and-ribs restaurant is nice, but it doesn't always make an ideal backdrop for more than 40 women in a Bible study, at least not on a regular basis.

"Nobody was complaining, everybody was being generous," explains Billy Cummings, pastor of New Love Ministries church in Sacramento, describing the church's search for a building of its own. "But you just get to a point where you know you need more space."

So the young church, begun almost by happenstance just two years ago, began looking for a space within its budget, and eventually was offered too good a deal to pass up: a local Jewish man renovated a vacant building he owned, and asked New Love Ministries to simply pick up the rent. Sundays see about 125 in attendance; weekly Bible studies include more; and, in a twist that would thrill most pastors, about twice as many families support the church financially as actually attend it. Most of all, more than 45 people have been baptized since the church began.

"There is growth, for sure," Cummings understates...
