Thesis:

Introduction:

I. Love is Not Just Emotion It is an Act of Obedience (John 15: 9-14)

- 9 "As the Father has loved Me, I have also loved you. Remain in My love.
- 10 If you keep My commands you will remain in My love, just as I have kept My Father's commands and remain in His love.
- 11 "I have spoken these things to you so that My joy may be in you and your joy may be complete.
- 12 This is My command: Love one another as I have loved you.
- 13 No one has greater love than this, that someone would lay down his life for his friends.
- 14 You are My friends if you do what I command you.

Remain in God's Love and Know Joy

(John 13: 34 – 35)

34 "I give you a new command: Love one another. Just as I have loved you, you must also love one another. 35 By this all people will know that you are My disciples, if you have love for one another."

Love is a Command - A Witness of Christ

Guard Against Love Growing Cold (Matthew 24: 9-13)

- 9 "Then they will hand you over for persecution, and they will kill you. You will be hated by all nations because of My name.
- 10 Then many will take offense, betray one another and hate one another.
- 11 Many false prophets will rise up and deceive many.
- 12 Because lawlessness will multiply, the love of many will grow cold.
- 13 But the one who endures to the end will be delivered.

Lawlessness Makes Love Grow Cold

(Matthew 16:24)

Then Jesus said to His disciples, "If anyone wants to come with Me, he must deny himself, take up his cross, and follow Me.

Carrying One's Cross Is An Act of Love

(Galatians 5: 22-23)

- 22 But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faith,
- 23 gentleness, self-control. Against such things there is no law.

Can You See God's Love in You?

Stand Confident in God's Love! (I Corinthians 13: 1-8)

- 1 If I speak human or angelic languages but do not have love, I am a sounding gong or a clanging cymbal.
- 2 If I have the gift of prophecy and understand all mysteries and all knowledge, and if I have all faith so that I can move mountains but do not have love, I am nothing.
- 3 And if I donate all my goods to feed the poor, and if I give my body in order to boast but do not have love, I gain nothing.
- 4 Love is patient, love is kind. Love does not envy, is not boastful, is not conceited,
- 5 does not act improperly, is not selfish, is not provoked, and does not keep a record of wrongs.
- 6 Love finds no joy in unrighteousness but rejoices in the truth.
- 7 It bears all things, believes all things, hopes all things, endures all things.
- 8 Love never ends. But as for prophecies, they will come to an end; as for languages, they will cease; as for knowledge, it will come to an end.
