I. Need More Men Like Jairus (Luke 8: 40 - 42a)

40 So it was, when Jesus returned, that the multitude welcomed Him, for they were all waiting for Him. 41 And behold, there came a man named Jairus, and he was a ruler of the synagogue. And he fell down at Jesus' feet and begged Him to come to his house, 42a for he had an only daughter about 12 years of age, and she was dying.

Jairus was not afraid to trust Jesus publically.

Jairus went to Jesus himself.

Jairus invited Jesus into his home.

Don't Let Jesus Pass By (Luke 8: 42b – 48)

42b But as He went, the multitudes thronged Him. 43 Now a woman, having a flow of blood for twelve years, who had spent all her livelihood on physicians and could not be healed by any,

44 came from behind and touched the border of His garment. And immediately her flow of blood stopped.

45 And Jesus said, "Who touched Me?"

When all denied it, Peter and those with him said, "Master, the multitudes throng and press You, and You say, 'Who touched Me?'"

46 But Jesus said, "Somebody touched Me, for I perceived power going out from Me."

47 Now when the woman saw that she was not hidden, she came trembling; and falling down before Him, she declared to Him in the presence of all the people the reason she had touched Him and how she was healed immediately.

48 And He said to her, "Daughter, be of good cheer; your faith has made you well. Go in peace."

The Woman put forth her energy

Her <u>strategy</u> was to touch Jesus, the healer.

Because she was <u>unclean</u>, she faced the death penalty for touching others.

Jesus was her hope at all cost.

She was healed physically. Her blood flow stopped.

She was healed <u>spiritually</u>. His blood would <u>soon</u> flow for her. He called her "Daughter".

Jesus is <u>tender</u> towards her. Her healing/salvation brought <u>peace</u>.

Believe in His Sovereign Authority (Luke 8: 49 – 56)

49 While He was still speaking, someone came from the ruler of the synagogue's house, saying to him, "Your daughter is dead. Do not trouble the Teacher." 50 But when Jesus heard it, He answered him, saying, "Do not be afraid; only believe, and she will be made well."

51 When He came into the house, He permitted no one to go in except Peter, James, and John, and the father and mother of the girl.

52 Now all wept and mourned for her; but He said, "Do not weep; she is not dead, but sleeping."

53 And they ridiculed Him, knowing that she was dead.

54 But He put them all outside, took her by the hand and called, saying, "Little girl, arise."

55 Then her spirit returned, and she arose immediately. And He commanded that she be given something to eat.

56 And her parents were astonished, but He charged them to tell no one what had happened.

Jairus' urgent matter diverted.

Jairus did not blame Jesus, but instead believed Him.

Mocking - Unbelief is <u>unrewarded</u>.

Believers are honored.
