According to a United Nation's Report, 2008 marked the first time in history that more than half the world's population was living in towns and cities.

Asian & Hispanic populations were growing more rapidly than Caucasians.

Economically, 2011 Pew Research Center Study showed:

- 1) Wealth gaps between white, blacks and hispanics
- 2) Median wealth white households are 20 times that of black households and 18 times that of Hispanic.
