I. Godly Moms Have a Godly Focus (II Peter 3: 10 – 13)

10 But the Day of the Lord will come like a thief; on that day the heavens will pass away with a loud noise, the elements will burn and be dissolved, and the earth and the works on it will be disclosed.

11 Since all these things are to be destroyed in this way, it is clear what sort of people you should be in holy conduct and godliness

12 as you wait for and earnestly desire the coming of the day of God. The heavens will be on fire and be dissolved because of it, and the elements will melt with the heat.

13 But based on His promise, we wait for the new heavens and a new earth, where righteousness will dwell.

II. Godly Mom's Make an Imprint on Others! (II Timothy 1: 3 – 5)

3 I thank God, whom I serve with a clear conscience as my ancestors did, when I constantly remember you in my prayers night and day.

4 Remembering your tears, I long to see you so that I may be filled with joy,

5 clearly recalling your sincere faith that first lived in your grandmother Lois, then in your mother Eunice, and that I am convinced is in you also.

(Luke 1: 26 - 55)

26 In the sixth month, the angel Gabriel was sent by God to a town in Galilee called Nazareth,

27 to a virgin engaged to a man named Joseph, of the house of David. The virgin's name was Mary.

28 And the angel came to her and said, "Rejoice, favored woman! The Lord is with you."

29 But she was deeply troubled by this statement, wondering what kind of greeting this could be.

30 Then the angel told her:

Do not be afraid, Mary, for you have found favor with God.

31 Now listen: You will conceive and give birth to a son, and you will call His name Jesus.

32 He will be great and will be called the Son of the Most High, and the Lord God will give Him the throne of His father David.

33 He will reign over the house of Jacob forever, and His kingdom will have no end.

34 Mary asked the angel, "How can this be, since I have not been intimate with a man?"

35 The angel replied to her: "The Holy Spirit will come upon you, and the power of the Most High will overshadow you. Therefore, the holy One to be born will be called the Son of God.

36 And consider your relative Elizabeth—even she has conceived a son in her old age, and this is the sixth month for her who was called childless.

37 For nothing will be impossible with God."

38 "I am the Lord's slave," said Mary. "May it be done to me according to your word." Then the angel left her.

39 In those days Mary set out and hurried to a town in the hill country of Judah

40 where she entered Zechariah's house and greeted Elizabeth.

41 When Elizabeth heard Mary's greeting, the baby leaped inside her, and Elizabeth was filled with the Holy Spirit.

42 Then she exclaimed with a loud cry:

"You are the most blessed of women, and your child will be blessed!

43 How could this happen to me, that the mother of my Lord should come to me? (More of passage on back)

- 44 For you see, when the sound of your greeting reached my ears, the baby leaped for joy inside me!
- 45 She who has believed is blessed because what was spoken to her by the Lord will be fulfilled!"
- 46 And Mary said: My soul proclaims the greatness of the Lord, 47 and my spirit has rejoiced in God my Savior,
- 48 because He has looked with favor on the humble condition of His slave. Surely, from now on all generations will call me blessed,
- 49 because the Mighty One has done great things for me, and His name is holy.
- 50 His mercy is from generation to generation on those who fear Him.
- 51 He has done a mighty deed with His arm; He has scattered the proud because of the thoughts of their hearts;
- 52 He has toppled the mighty from their thrones and exalted the lowly.
- 53 He has satisfied the hungry with good things and sent the rich away empty.
- 54 He has helped His servant Israel, mindful of His mercy, 55 just as He spoke to our ancestors, to Abraham and his descendants forever.

(Genesis 19: 12 - 17 & 23 - 26)

12 Then the angels said to Lot, "Do you have anyone else here: a son-in-law, your sons and daughters, or anyone else in the city who belongs to you? Get them out of this place,

13 for we are about to destroy this place because the outcry against its people is so great before the Lord, that the Lord has sent us to destroy it."

14 So Lot went out and spoke to his sons-in-law, who were going to marry his daughters. "Get up," he said. "Get out of this place, for the Lord is about to destroy the city!" But his sons-in-law thought he was joking.

15 At daybreak the angels urged Lot on: "Get up! Take your wife and your two daughters who are here, or you will be swept away in the punishment of the city."

16 But he hesitated. Because of the Lord's compassion for him, the men grabbed his hand, his wife's hand, and the hands of his two daughters. Then they brought him out and left him outside the city.

17 As soon as the angels got them outside, one of them said, "Run for your lives! Don't look back and don't stop anywhere on the plain! Run to the mountains, or you will be swept away!"

23 The sun had risen over the land when Lot reached Zoar.

24 Then out of the sky the Lord rained burning sulfur on Sodom and Gomorrah from the Lord.

25 He demolished these cities, the entire plain, all the inhabitants of the cities, and whatever grew on the ground. 26 But his wife looked back and became a pillar of salt.

Where Was Her Focus?

Her looking back revealed her disobedience, unbelief, and bondage to the World around her.

(Luke 17:34)

I tell you, on that night two will be in one bed: One will be taken and the other will be left. Remember!
