Thesis:

Worship Comes From Within One's Soul and Produces Joy

Introduction:

There is horizontal worship, & very little vertical worship today.

Proskuneo =

To Bow Down

To Stoop Down

To Fall Down

To Adore

To Show Absolute Reverence, Homage or Submission

To Kiss

To Prostrate Oneself or To Touch One's Nose to the Ground

I. Encounter God and Worship Him! (II Chronicles 6: 40 - 7:3)

40 "Now, my God, may your eyes be open and your ears attentive to the prayers offered in this place.

41 "Now arise, O LORD God, and come to your resting place, you and the ark of your might. May your priests, O LORD God, be clothed with salvation, may your saints rejoice in your goodness. 42 O LORD God, do not reject your anointed one. Remember the great love promised to David your servant."

- 1 When Solomon finished praying, fire came down from heaven and consumed the burnt offering and the sacrifices, and the glory of the LORD filled the temple.
- 2 The priests could not enter the temple of the LORD because the glory of the LORD filled it.
- 3 When all the Israelites saw the fire coming down and the glory of the LORD above the temple, they knelt on the pavement with their faces to the ground, and they worshiped and gave thanks to the LORD, saying, "He is good; his love endures forever."

(Revelation 5: 1 – 14)

1 Then I saw in the right hand of him who sat on the throne a scroll with writing on both sides and sealed with seven seals.

- 2 And I saw a mighty angel proclaiming in a loud voice, "Who is worthy to break the seals and open the scroll?"
- 3 But no one in heaven or on earth or under the earth could open the scroll or even look inside it.
- 4 I wept and wept because no one was found who was worthy to open the scroll or look inside.
- 5 Then one of the elders said to me, "Do not weep! See, the Lion of the tribe of Judah, the Root of David, has triumphed. He is able to open the scroll and its seven seals."
- 6 Then I saw a Lamb, looking as if it had been slain, standing in the center of the throne, encircled by the four living creatures and the elders. He had 7 horns and seven eyes, which are the seven spirits of God sent out into all the earth.
- 7 He came and took the scroll from the right hand of him who sat on the throne.
- 8 And when he had taken it, the four living creatures and the twenty-four elders fell down before the Lamb. Each one had a harp and they were holding golden bowls full of incense, which are the prayers of the saints.
- 9 And they sang a new song: "You are worthy to take the scroll and to open its seals, because you were slain, and with your blood you purchased men for God from every tribe and language and people and nation.
- 10 You have made them to be a kingdom and priests to serve our God, and they will reign on the earth."
- 11 Then I looked and heard the voice of many angels, numbering thousands upon thousands, and ten thousand times ten thousand. They encircled the throne and the living creatures and the elders.
- 12 In a loud voice they sang: "Worthy is the Lamb, who was slain, to receive power and wealth and wisdom and strength and honor and glory and praise!"
- 13 Then I heard every creature in heaven and on earth and under the earth and on the sea, and all that is in them, singing: "To him who sits on the throne and to the Lamb be praise and honor and glory and power, for ever and ever!"
- 14 The four living creatures said, "Amen," and the elders fell down and worshiped.

Again, God Does Not Want Horizontal Worship

God's Desire For Worship Is Found in:

(John 4: 23 - 24)

23 Yet a time is coming and has now come when the true worshipers will worship the Father in spirit and truth, for they are the kind of worshipers the Father seeks.

24 God is spirit, and his worshipers must worship in spirit and in truth."

(Psalm 63: 1 - 5)

- 1 O God, you are my God, earnestly I seek you; my soul thirsts for you, my body longs for you, in a dry and weary land where there is no water.
- 2 I have seen you in the sanctuary and beheld your power and your glory.
- 3 Because your love is better than life, my lips will glorify you.
- 4 I will praise you as long as I live, and in your name I will lift up my hands.
- 5 My soul will be satisfied as with the richest of foods; with singing lips my mouth will praise you.

George Barna, the famous author and statistician, says:
